

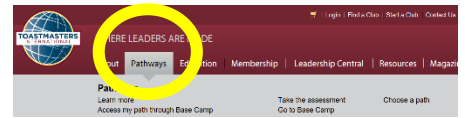
PATHWAYS – WORKING YOUR PATH

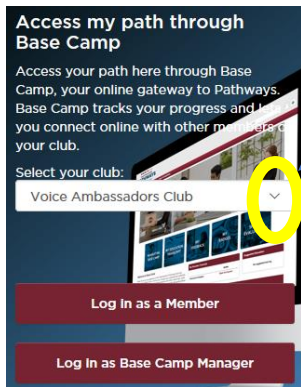
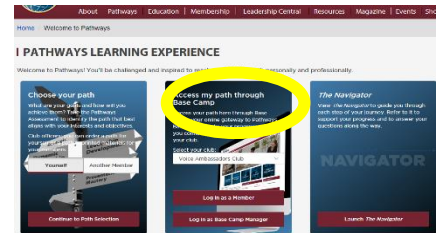
From the Toastmasters Home Page, you can still get to Pathways by clicking on Pathways for the dropdown, then choose “Go to Base Camp”



You always start from the Pathways Start Page

NOTE: Your LOGIN ID and Password are the same for Toastmasters and for Pathways

The Start Page has 3 Blue Tiles:
Click on **Access my path through Base Camp**

Member of more than 1 club? Use Drop-Down Arrow to choose which club. The club you choose becomes your home club, until the next time you sign-in.

Click on “Log in as a Member” to work your Path or use tutorials.

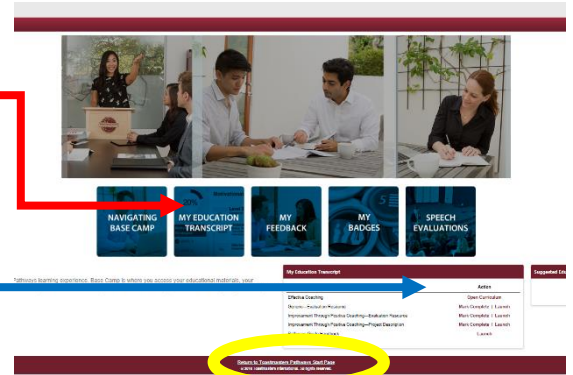
Are you a “Base Camp Manager?” Click there to track member progress or approve Level completions.

NOTE: From this page, you can go back to the main Toastmasters website, change home club, or change between member and Base Camp Manager.

Return to Toastmasters Pathways Start Page

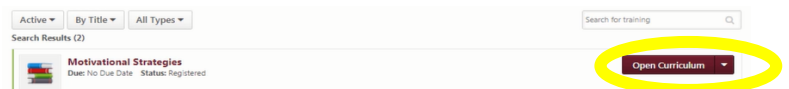
When clicking on **BLUE TILE** (above) you will see your **Education Transcript**, including your **Path**

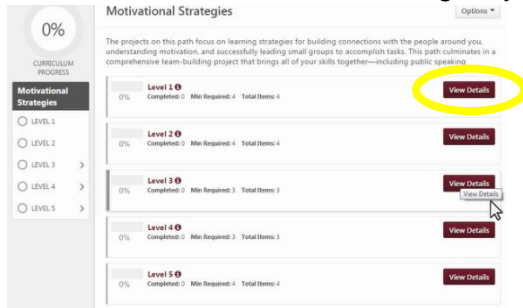
- Click on Open Curriculum



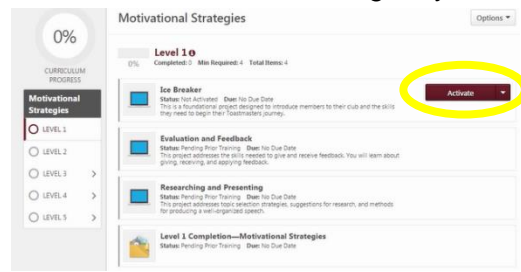
Your Path will open

1. An overview of the Path appears. Click on Level 1 **View Detail** burgundy bar



2. Level 1 appears. Click on the **ACTIVATE** burgundy bar

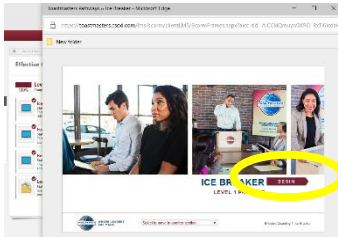


When starting, the **ONLY** burgundy bar, is for the Ice Breaker. This project **MUST** be completed, before continuing to the other projects.

- When **ACTIVATING**, the Project will open in a separate window (pop-up). Give it time, it is a little slow,

Working the Ice Breaker

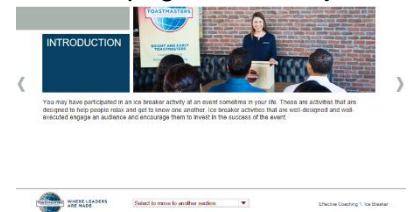
1. Click **BEGIN** to start



2. First page: tutorial on how to read project Use side arrows to go forward/backward



3. Third page starts Project

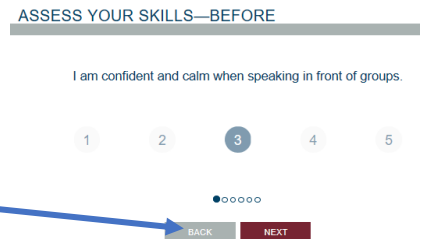


4. Some pages give more options **Checklist** opens in a new window



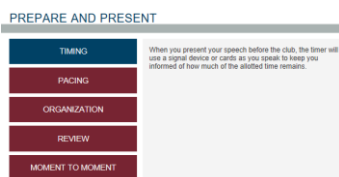
5. You **MUST** complete the **ASSESS SKILLS-BEFORE** & again **AFTER** for project completion.

Be sure to click **NEXT** to go to next question.



6. Watch the videos, use “NEXT” buttons, and watch for other additional options to get the most out of it: **Below:** TIMING is blue; all others are burgundy.

Click on **PACING**, it turns blue & paragraph appears. Then continue down list.



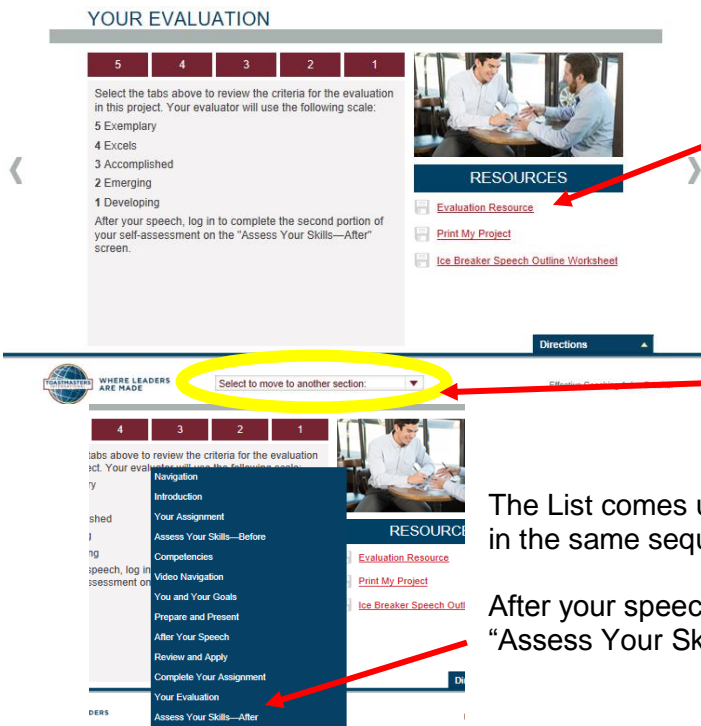
Below: Click on **MORE** for another paragraph

Finding Your Evaluation Resource (Form)

Every Project has a page, with the option to print/download your Evaluation, Project, and other item(s). This page is always called YOUR EVALUATION

You can also return to any section of the project, including this page.

Use Drop-Down Arrow next to "Select to move to another section"

The List comes up, giving you the option to go directly to a specific point, in the same sequence it appears, when working the project.

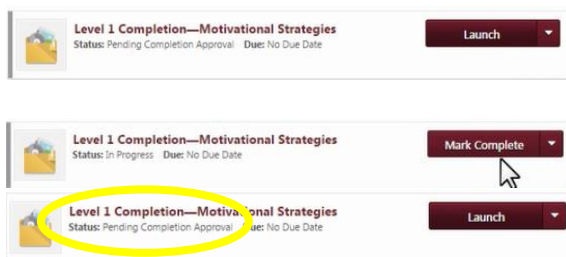
After your speech, don't forget to complete the "Assess Your Skills-After" (*No one else sees your answers but you*)

Completing Level 1

Once you have completed the Ice Breaker Project
(Includes: Ice Breaker speech and the Initial & Final Self-Assessments)

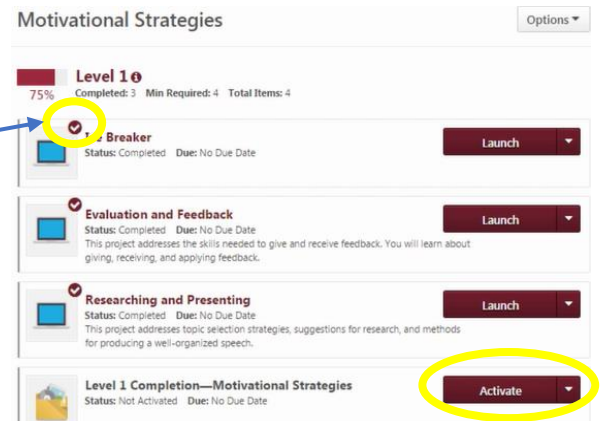
- The check mark appears to the left of Ice Breaker
- The burgundy bars appear next to the next 2 projects:
 - o Evaluate and Feedback
 - o Researching and Presenting

Follow the same steps to complete the next projects.
Once all 3 projects are completed, Level 1 Completion opens.
You are ready to submit Level 1 Completion to your VPE.

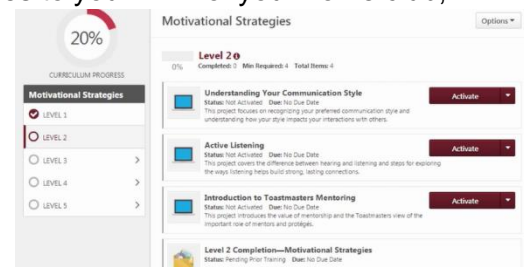


notifying the VPE that a Level Completion request is pending.

4. Once your VP Education/Base Camp Manager approves it,
 - The **check** will appear and **Status** changes to "Completed."
 - Level 2 will be available with burgundy bars on all 3 projects, so you can open and begin working all 3 projects.
 - Continue to work Level 2 the same way as Level 1.



1. Click on **Activate** across from Level 1 Completion.
2. Burgundy bar changes to **Launch**. Then click **Launch**. A PDF will open, with information about your submission.
3. Now click **Mark Complete**. The **Status** changes to "Pending Completion Approval" and an email goes to your VPE of your home club,



Tutorials and Resources

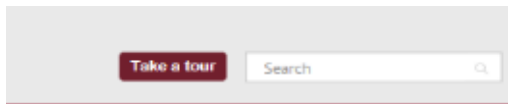
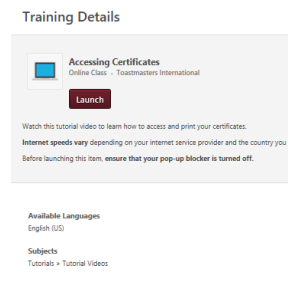
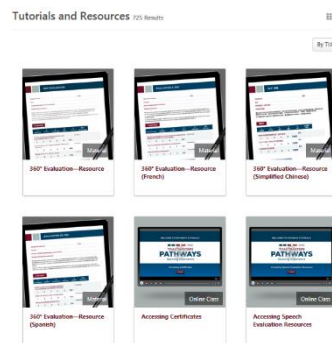
Tutorials and Resources are available to assist us in understanding, working, and navigating Base Camp.

- Access is located in the upper left corner, on the burgundy bar.
- There are video classes, written tutorials, evaluation forms, project description, and more.
- It can be accessed from the Home Page (below) or while working your Path.
- It can also be accessed by a direct "Search" in the upper left corner, above the burgundy bar.



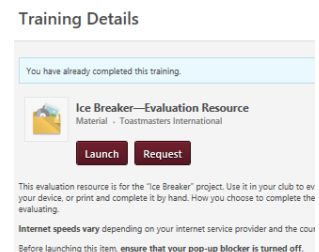
Must use Drop-Down to access (click on burgundy bar, then Drop Down).
All Tutorials and Resources are listed in alphabetical order.

- Click on a resource (to right)
- A pop-up comes up (to far right) (like the video class "Accessing Certificates")
- Then click on **Launch**
- The tutorial will open in a new window



SEARCHING BY NAME

- Type in name (ex: Ice Breaker-Evaluation Resource)
- You can type it all, but a few letters, will give you some options
- Click on the magnifying glass (to right of search typed in)
- A full list will be displayed (seen to left)
- In this case, you'd click on the second one for English for the Ice Breaker Evaluation form (unless you want French, Spanish or Chinese)
- This Pop-Up gives you the option to Launch or Request (seen right).
